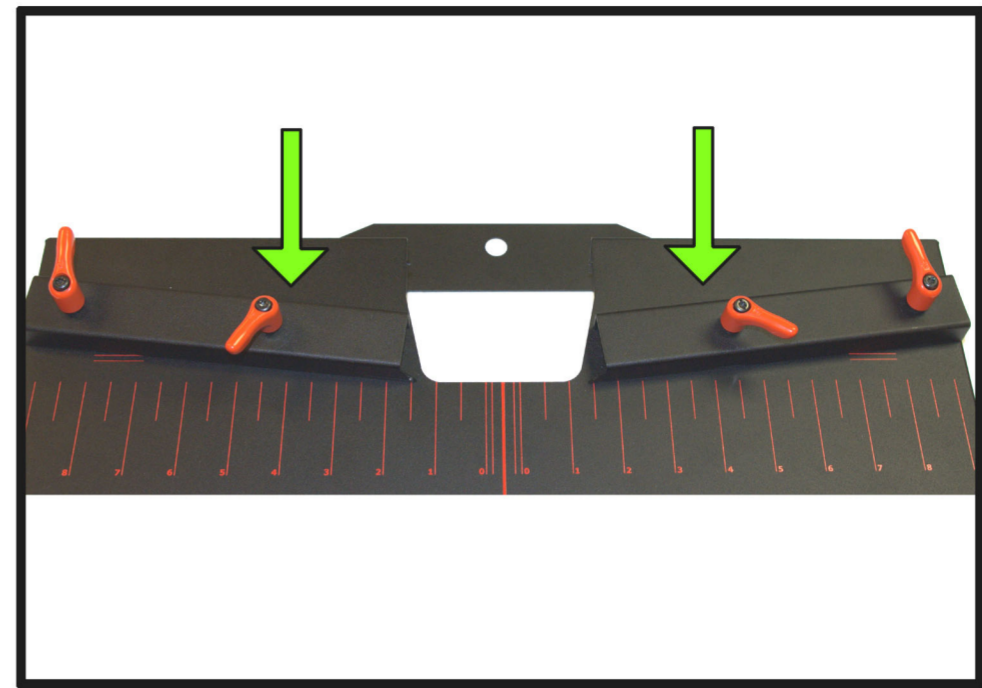
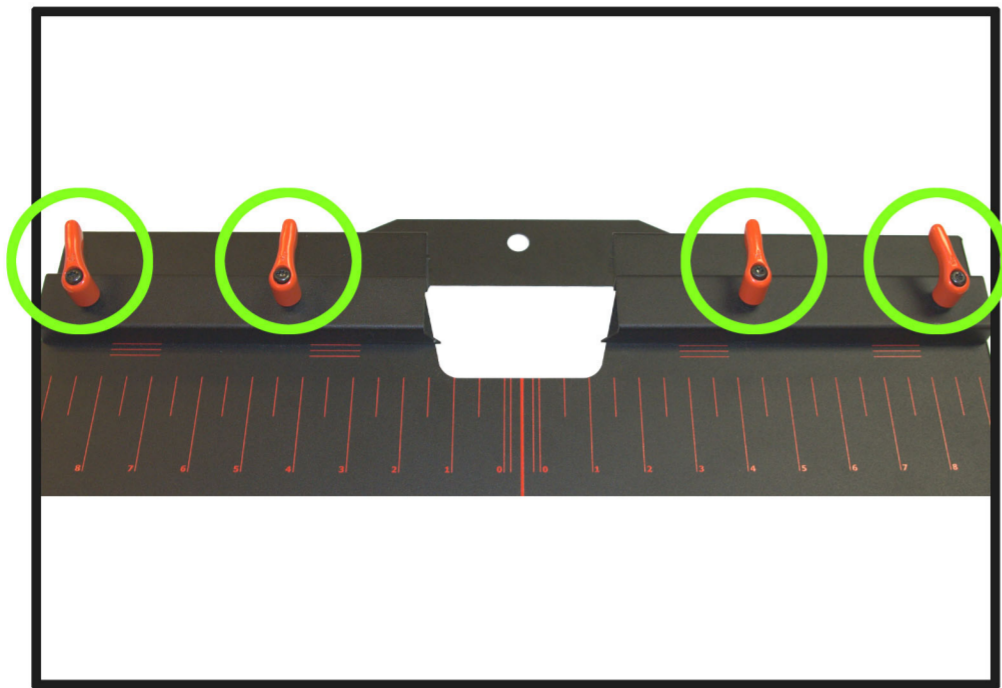
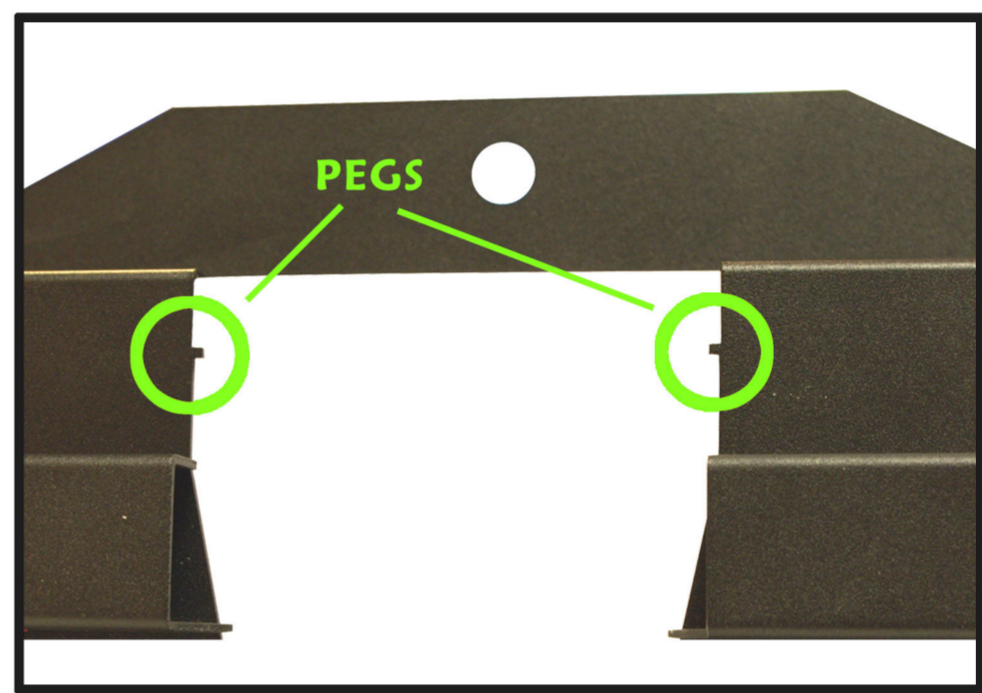
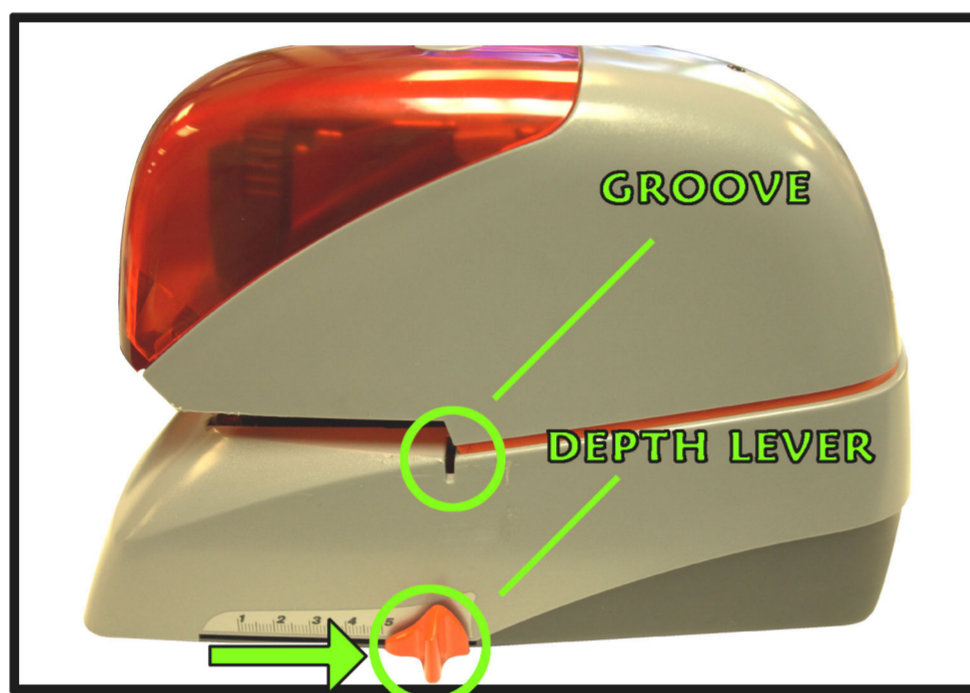


To ensure safe shipping, your new Silver Strike Prime stitching system has been separated into its two component parts, the table and stitcher. To assemble your machine and get to stitching, follow these easy steps:

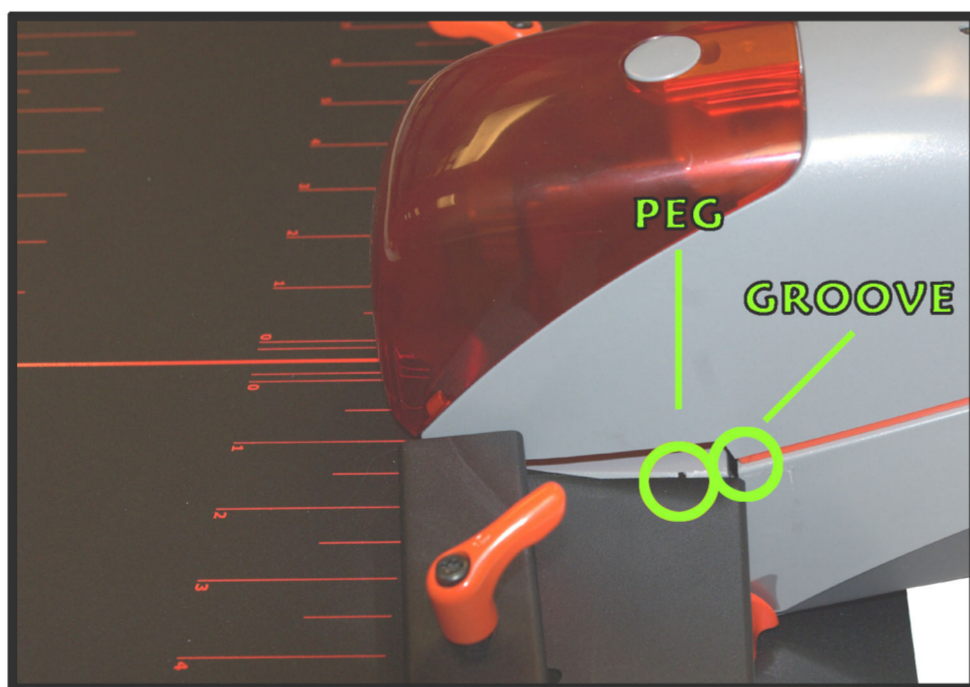
1. Take your table and loosen the levers on the adjustable backstops. Shift the backstops toward the guidelines below. This will provide space to insert your stitcher.



2. Check your stitcher unit and make sure the built-in depth lever is pushed all the way back to the 5" mark. Take note of the two pegs extending from the table; these will fit in the grooves of the stitcher and hold it in place.



3. Tilt the stitcher in a downward angle while slowly guiding the pegs towards the grooves. Lift the table up a few inches to get a better angle. If the pegs get stuck on the plastic, don't force them! Push the pegs up from the underside of the table to give the pegs the 1-2 millimeters of lift they need to slide into place.



4. Check under the stitcher to make sure that the central rubber foot is aligned with the hole on the bottom of the table. Your Silver Strike Prime Stitcher is now securely assembled; straighten the aluminum backstops, plug in the foot pedal and power supply and happy stitching!
